Indigenous Language Acquisition Fund – Individual Language Learning Activities

Purpose: Funds (individual max. of \$6000/yr) are available to NWTTA, GNWT Indigenous Language Teachers to improve their Indigenous language skills. Activities with Elders or other Indigenous language speakers, where there is the opportunity to hear and speak their language and learn more about language, traditional ways and beliefs are eligible. This funding could also be used to connect Indigenous Language Teachers with a language mentor in the classroom.

- honoraria to Elder/language mentors
- substitute costs where applicable and/or warranted
- materials
- travel costs
